The Interfaith Center on Corporate Responsibility is a coalition of faith-based institutional investors. ICCR seeks to build a more just and sustainable society by integrating social values into corporate and investor decisions.

ICCR has three fee-based levels of organizational relationship: Member, Associate Member, and Affiliate Member.

Member: Members are faith-based institutional investor organizations or faith-based group associations of investors, such as religious communities, denominations, faith-based pension funds, and healthcare corporations. Members screen their investments, sponsor shareholder resolutions, and directly engage company management.

Associate Member: Associates are primarily secular or other non-affiliated faith-based institutional investors that partner with ICCR Members in shareholder advocacy.

Affiliate Member: Affiliates are organizations or groups with a holistic interest in shareholder advocacy but seek limited involvement in ICCR's collective efforts.
